Transports:

Bus: The Sibra public transport network allows you to travel by bus in various communes of the Grand Annecy.

Please note that you cannot use your credit card to pay your bus ticket. You can buy your ticket by using cash or e-tickets that you can buy via SIBRA application (in French). The price of a single ticket is 1,50 euros.

Bike: There are many bicycle rental companies in the Annecy area.

At the same time, the Greater Annecy agglomeration community offers an accessible public rental service called [Vélonecy](#). This rental fleet has 600 city bikes, 200 electrically assisted bikes and folding bikes. During the summer, [40 electrically assisted Vélonecy rental stations](#) are available throughout the Annecy conurbation.

What to do in Annecy?

City side

1. Lose yourself in the narrow streets of old Annecy known as the "Little Venice" of the Alps, old Annecy can be explored on foot along the water's edge. The canals of the Thiou wind through the old town and bear witness to its past.

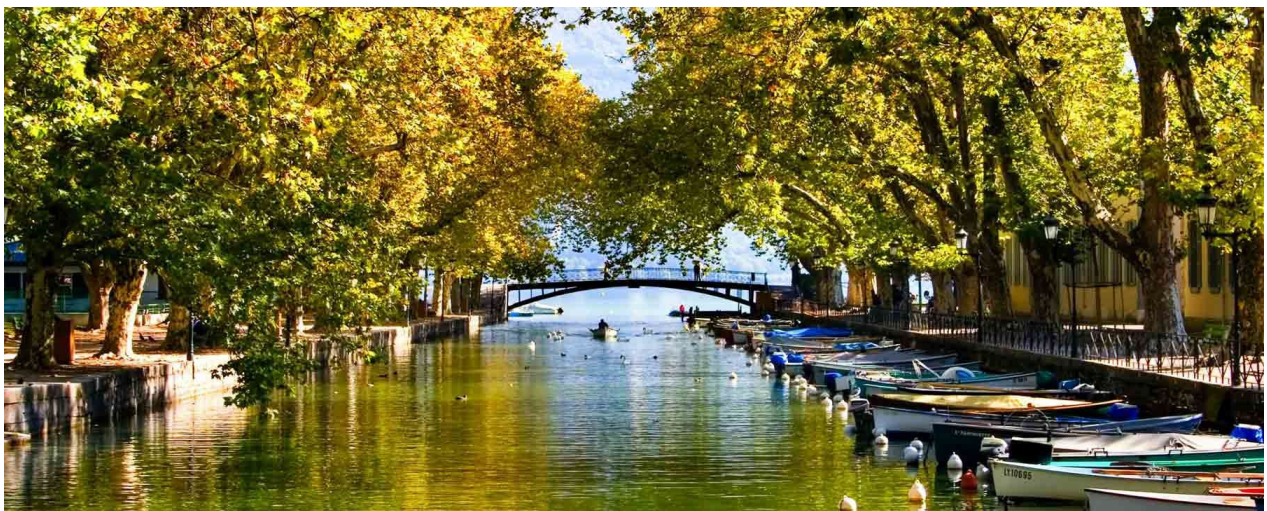




2. Discover the Jardins de l'Europe opposite Swan Island. From the old town, we follow the course of the Thiou to reach the beautiful Jardins de l'Europe with its century-old trees.

From the Jardins de l'Europe, we follow the shores of the lake to the famous Pont des Amours. Romantic atmosphere! Then it's on to the Pâquier esplanade.



Lake side

1. Walk on the water between Annecy-le-Vieux and Veyrier-du-Lac with a footbridge. It takes you to Veyrier-du-Lac. It's a great way to take a break from the road and make the most of soft mobility.



2. Pedal along the lakeside bike path.



3. Paddleboarding, canoeing, pedal-boating (during summer)
